FAMILY CAMP WEEKEND



SPANISH TRAIL SCOUT RESERVATION SPRING 2010

The Family Camp Weekend is a weekend Scouting activity designed for a boy and his family. You come to camp together, sleep together and do things you want to do together. If you wish you can hike, fish, swim or boat, then spend time in the activity areas with bows and arrows, bb-guns or work on leatherwork in handicraft. A camp map and a schedule of events and activities will be provided to you at check-in.



WHEN:

There will be 3 Family Camps this spring with a maximum number of 600 people per each camp. Reservations will be on a first come/first serve basis. **BE SURE TO REGISTER EARLY.** The dates are listed on the registration form. Make sure to mark your first and second choice and give a complete list of family members that will be attending. Check-in will begin at 3:00 PM, Friday afternoon.

WHERE:

Camp Euchee & Jambo, Spanish Trail Scout Reservation, DeFuniak Springs, FL. Located approximately 5 miles west of DeFuniak Springs off Highway 90. Look for the green "Boy Scout Camp" sign. Turn and follow Boy Scout Road until you reach the wood and stone gateway that marks the entrance to the camp. Once you've entered the Scout Reservation follow the paved road until you have passed the earth dam and traveled up the hill. Henson Hall is the first building on the right.

WHO: All registered Scouts and Scouters and their families.

COST: \$12.00 per person. (Children 5 and under are free)

WHAT TO BRING:

Each family provides their own tent and food. You should also bring the following: Sleeping Bags or Blankets, Cooking Equipment, Towels, Toilet Articles, Comfortable Shoes, Clothing, Swimming Trunks, Flashlights or Gas Lantern, Fishing Equipment and Lots of Scouting Spirit.

THE CAMP PROVIDES:

Accident Insurance for all registered scouts and Scouters, First Aid, Shower Facilities, Planned Activities, Camp Staff, Saturday Night Campfire, Cracker Barrel, Stocked Trading Post, Sunday Morning Church Service and Lots of Fun!! All campsites have access to a toilet, shower, tables and drinking water. Adequate space will be provided to set up your tent.

CAMP SAFETY:

1. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED ON CAMP AT ANY TIME.**

THOSE FOUND WITH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.

Please discuss these rules with your participants before arrival.

2. **No vehicles or bicycles are allowed in campsites.**
3. **Closed Toed Shoes must be worn at all times.**
4. **No flames in tents at any time.**
5. **Avoid all snakes.**
6. **No firearms, ammunition or fireworks are allowed.**
7. **Gas lanterns and stoves allowed for adults only.**
8. **Boys are not permitted to carry matches.**
9. **Axes and hatchets are for adults only.**
10. **All children must have adult supervision at all times.**
11. **No Pets.**

There is a 600 person limit (including family members) so please turn this form in as soon as possible. Final payment is due with this form. Late payments and "walk-ins" cannot be accepted. *No refunds can be given for no-shows or cancellations.*
